

Clive's Comments

It is hard to focus on where the country is with Covid. As far as I can see we have survived with low infection rates due to being an island and quickly closing our borders. Then, excluding the crazy lockdown period in Victoria, we have managed to keep the virus in check. As a nation we got to this stage with relatively low pressure on our health system. The way forward from here is vaccination to the stage where the majority of Australians are covered such that if we have a large outbreak there won't be a huge demand on the health

This is all good but if we were to write down what is happening as a play, it would be a cross between Keystone Cops and Yes Minister. We have two vaccines available, one in unlimited supplies and one that is dependent on foreign production. One has almost now side effects and one has a tiny bit more. Either is better than none. The rest of the world has taken up whatever vaccines are available and are getting to stages of >60% vaccinated yet we are <5% Somewhere between media, state and federal politics we have convinced a large proportion of the public that the AZ vaccine is too dangerous and/or that there is no real need to get vaccinated.

First, some statistics from the UK where they have 50% fully vaccinated and 65% with a single dose. The vaccination rates are good and spread across the whole adult population. Their infection and death rates have dropped substantially and they are opening up socially and economically. The figures I recently read on the side effects of AZ for 25 to 30 year olds in UK were 11 people had serious effects (not necessarily die) out of every million vaccinations. Clive's Comments continued...

...a serious side effect and for every million who get Covid, 800 will die. In any year 38 out of every million passengers/drivers die in car accidents. Pfizer has even less side effects. Seems the arguments for taking any vaccine are pretty strong.

Second, we have little hope of avoiding these lockdowns, restrictions on movement and border closures until we have 70+% vaccinated. We are now being governed by a series of medical bureaucrats who may (or may not) be good at understanding the effects of SARS type viruses on human populations. They are not elected and not accountable to anyone but the senior politicians in their jurisdiction. Good, or bad they have no or little understanding of the business community nor do they have a handle on the psychological effects on the wider community of this constant restraint on our lives. To them the only acceptable conclusion is eradication of the virus from the community which may be possible but at what cost? Where is the balanced approach?

Third, there seems to be a complete inability for the state leaders to agree on a uniform course of action that works for the whole country. It is almost a case of 'I can shut down business faster than you can' and 'Our state is better than yours and we can exist without you'. One day we have the Queensland Premier saying 'Victorians please come to Queensland ' and two weeks later she is quarantining Victorians who took her up on the invite. Then we have WA tourism advertising on Victorian TV. People respond and buy tickets then a week later they are locked out.

These 'leaders' are playing games with people's lives and seem to do so at a whim. I am not just talking about the actual people travelling between states but the businesses that rely on them. I worry that we have now hit a stage where people are just too scared to bother booking. Even if they book at the last minute they can still get locked up. Last week there was an airline steward who tested positive for Covid so every one who was on any of her flights or walked through the terminals at the same time ae now being quarantined. They did nothing wrong and had no chance to alter their plans to avoid the problem as it only arose well after they arrived at their destination.

I haven't had to quarantine (and hope not to) but being locked in a room for 14 days is more restrictive than many low security prisoners have to endure. I just spent eight days in a hospital bed and nearly went mad even though I was able to walk around and even leave the ward. There are also reports of people being scared to go out in case they happen to be at a venue where a positive person happens to walk past. They are not scared of the Covid but being locked up – at home or at a hotel. Worst of all there is no avenue for appeal. If the local health authorities deem you are a risk, your locked up.

These leaders will not get together and agree on how, when and why borders will be locked. They won't come out and state what has to happen before these lockdowns and closures will stop. If it wasn't so damaging to our economy and the mental state of the community it would be laughable. It doesn't matter if they are a Liberal or Labour government they just cannot, or will not address the problems they are creating.

At least we are in an industry that is not really affected by this behaviour. In fact if anything the more they do this the more people will holiday at home and not risk travelling or even shopping at major centres. We are lucky we have all chosen to work in the nursery industry and we just need to make sure we keep great plants going out to a garden loving public.
