Clive's Comments

It is spring in Australia and for those in the north it is moving into summer, whilst we in the south are still moving out of winter. We even had a couple of late frosts in October which is generally not a problem for the nursery industry. Urban gardeners have little damage due to the fact that the volumes of concrete in the suburbs are such a massive heat sink that the frosts barely touch the plants. The gardeners in the country are aware of the late frosts and generally don't plant out their frost sensitive plants until November. It is the veggie farmers who sometimes get caught out when the plants come in to flower a bit early and are then hit. SA has done it a bit tough with several very wet weekends and then those massive storms that left a trail of destruction. Some of the wholesale nurseries and farmers in the plains to the north of Adelaide copped some real floods. There was the crazy case of a grower with plants on benches wilting due to lack of water while the area below the bench was flooded preventing the pumps from coming on. It is the nature of primary production in Australia. At least as nurseries we have sales all year. I feel sorry for the cherry farmers who have one harvest period and if there is a storm during that time they lose all or part of the year's income...

Clive's Comments Continued...

Spring in Victoria seems to have been reasonable with good sales across the full plant range. Sydney has done well with a cooler than average October and rural NSW is doing okay after those good early rains. Some country areas are a little wet but should dry out. Of course with floods on the Lachlan, Darling, Murrumbidgee, King, Ovens, Goulburn and upper Murray there will be a lot of water running through the lower Murray system. Eildon is full, the snows are starting to melt and the farmers aren't calling for water so there will be high flows out of the Goulburn Valley. Those who have been calling for more environmental flows in the lower Murray and the Coorong should be happy this year.

The bigger question is what will happen over January and February. Will we have a heat wave where it is too hot to do anything but sit by the pool or beach or will we have one of those milder summers that keeps people in the garden? I suspect the latter but fear for next summer as the results of this wet spring and some good growing conditions will result in a thick, green bush. This will probably still be green and moist this summer but could lead to major fire conditions in 2017/8.

With the controversy over CFA and UFU in full swing it is just as well that fire conditions are mild this year. Still not sure why the argument is still there and where the root problem is. If 60,000 (or a majority thereof) are not happy with their management conditions and all the senior staff and board of the CFA have left or been pushed there must be a problem. Why are they still arguing? Is it because there is a faction that is trying to build an empire or are the mediators just hopeless? Whichever it is, I just wish someone would knock some heads together and come up with a solution.

Six weeks to Christmas and don't we all look forward to it. The long evenings, the fine food the time with family and the happy atmosphere that pervades the whole community is infectious. The majority of the population love all the trappings: decorations, music, stories, costumes and traditions. There will of course be the usual litany of anti-religious, politically correct complaints about the overtly Christian parables and symbols. Hopefully they will get closed down by the rest of us. It is Christmas and this is nominally a Christian country but even so there is no pressure to become Christian or to take up a more religious life.
