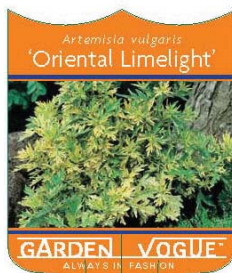

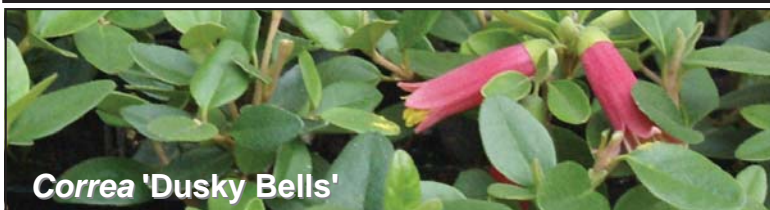

Clive's comments continued... aren't really there? If we treat these products as tools of the trade and use them as they were designed they will help us build our businesses. If we don't we will get left behind. If we get caught up too much we may also forget how to relate to our fellow humans.

Sometimes I marvel at what the new world of computers can do. I can now sit almost anywhere in the world and operate my office computers, or push a few buttons on my phone and find where I am and how to get where I want to go. The next minute I am frustrated because my computer is taking too long to open a file (30 seconds instead of 10) and I have to sit still and wait. Why am I doing this? So I can run a business selling plants. A contrast in itself. What will be next? I still remember crossing off boxes on several hundred cards to make a computer do a simple statistical analysis and the Commodore 64 and the Atari computer games.

Last month I wrote about the importance of children in the garden. I still think this is critical to a peaceful world. I also think it is critical for us as parents and grand parents to understand how the young are communicating. We must bring the two worlds together and plants and food are the best way to do it. The internet is a fantastic tool to learn about plants, to understand food and nutrition and to help everyone connect with growing things. In January I was doing a cooking demonstration at a Lavender Festival. There were some young kids in the group who just loved to cook. They wanted to try more foods and flavours and it felt good to expose them to some new dishes. It was also a buzz when they gave me some new recipes and ideas. It is all a matter of balance; new and old. technology and nature. If we can just get this message across we have succeeded.
