Clive's Comments

As a business that ships plants around the country our borders have always been an issue. There have always been blocks preventing certain plants entering different states from each other state. These blocks seem to be at random and often illogical. Each state is a law unto itself and it can be nigh on impossible to get any sort of logical review of why plants can or can't move across borders. Now we have got even worse with the Covid lockdowns.

We live in Victoria and even worse in Melbourne and are now the pariahs of Australia. Granted we have the worse Covid cases in Australia. We can accept that other towns and states want to remain free (or at least in control) of Covid 19. There are also some pretty selfish and stupid Victorians (and Australians) who will travel into disease free areas when they are contagious. So the fact that some states have shut out Victorians makes some level of sense. However, like so often in our modern world there are some pretty illogical rules.

The real issue is that many of the decisions made around the pandemic are illogical and some even appear to be politically based. 

Clive's Comments continued... that the decisions that needed to be made (and still need to be made) were not easy and were not guaranteed to return a positive result. Whatever the premiers/ministers decided some people would suffer but I feel that many of the decision makers have little understanding of how much damage a flattened economy can do to the emotional well being of the community. Add in social isolation and you have a world ripe for suicide, depression and associated disorders. We live in Melbourne and have a real concern about where the virus is headed. We have been cut off from the rest of Australia, are in lockdown again, have to wear masks and are facing even worse restrictions. The rest of Australia is heading out of the restrictions and businesses are working back to a new normal. We watch this with envy and frustration. We know that six weeks ago we were also in the clear but due to someone's incompetence we are now in trouble. The real anger stems from what is starting to appear as politically based decision making. First was Cedar meat works where several workers were diagnosed but they weren't shut down for several weeks. It seems they had a major (\$30million) shipment to China which would have ben cancelled. The company is a donator to the state ALP. The next outbreak came from escapes from the quarantine hotels. This only happened in Victoria where the security was done by a private firm using untrained casual workers. Another supporter of the ALP. Other states used the army and police and the management fell under the control of the health, police or security minister but here it was managed by Minister Pakula – who is responsible for Jobs, Precincts, Regions, Trade, Industry Sport and Major Events. None of these portfolios really relate to security. It appears that all the current clusters stem from these quarantine hotels. Other states had more relaxed stage three restrictions, reduced them earlier and had many fold less fines for Covid breaches. They approached the whole process with a greater understanding of the damages that the shutdowns were doing to the small business community and the harm to our social fabric the home lock downs and closing of community based sport were doing. They seemed to understand that a round of golf seemed so inconsequential to most of us but to some people it was what gave their lives meaning. This is not an easy world to live in nor to make decisions about but it is a different world for the public servants and politicians than for the working families and small business community. It is crucial that we move to a system where we realise that any and every job that can be kept alive is an essential job. It is crucial that we balance the medical and the economical and the social aspects of our communities. At least our sector sits on the good side of the ledger. Every business producing and retailing plants is helping the environment, improving the health and lifestyle if the community and adding to the economy. So what can we do? Act appropriately if we get sick. Maintain a clean and healthy environment and keep the social distancing. Finally we must keep producing good plants and making sure that our companies stay Covid free. We can, and must stay safe, healthy and positive so that the nursery sector can continue to supply plants to the wider gardening sector. Clive Larkman
