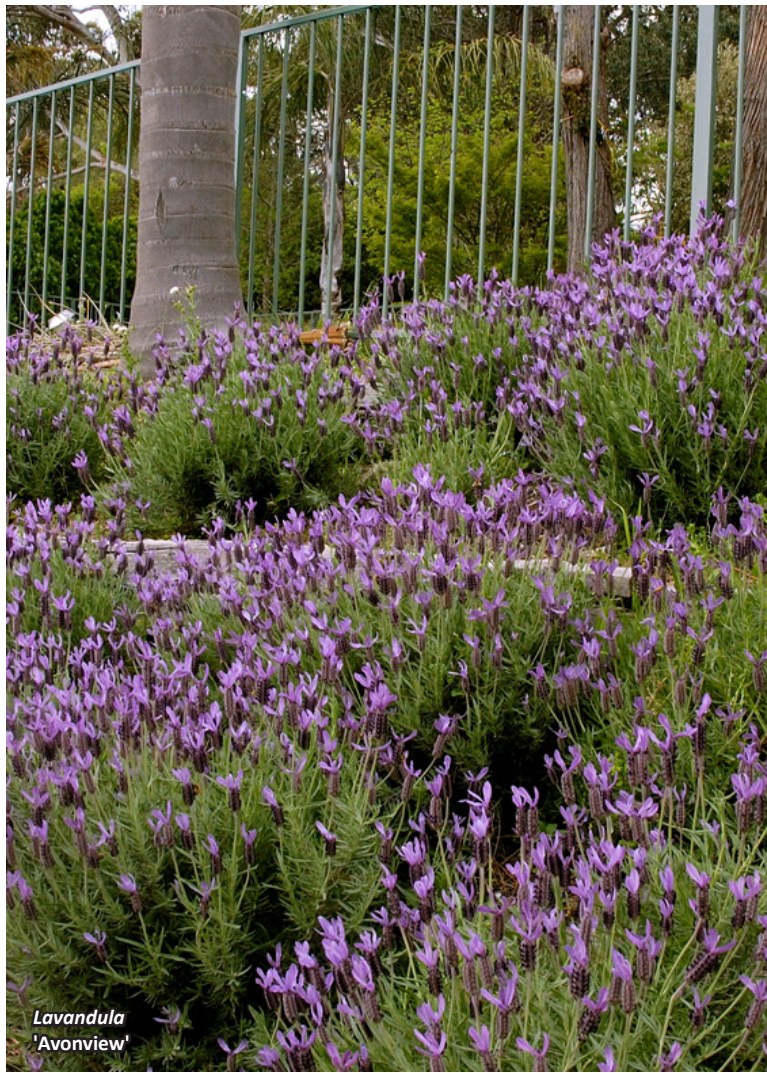

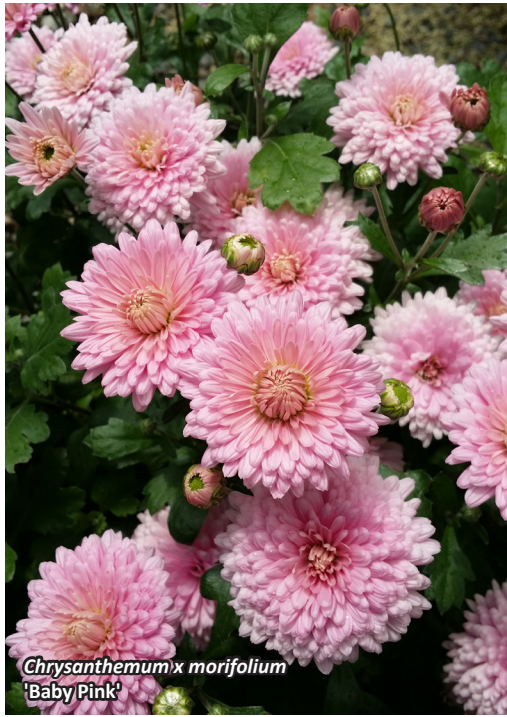

Clive's Comments continued...

.... It is also a good time to observe plants and how they grow. Some plants start to put on their fresh spring growth as soon as the equinox has passed. Others, like lavender put on bright green foliage as soon as we start to get a few weeks sun. Some deciduous trees leaf up by mid September and others are just starting to show bud burst. It is fascinating to watch and enjoy the explosion of colour and fragrance. It reminds me that we are fortunate to work in such a great industry.

We are in full planning mode for our Spring Plant Fair and Garden Expo in November. It takes a lot of time and effort to put on the event but the result is always a buzz. We have around 60 vendors and attract over 3000 attendees. We try and have unusual vendors who don't do a lot of events. Some are normally wholesale only and some are on-line vendors and some are retailers. All love what they do and do it very well. Our first one was in 2018 and have been there every year except 2020. Over that time we have built a core of vendors and attendees who have become a family. It is great to catch up each spring and see what is new.

It also feels good when we see all these people coming along and having a great time. Over the years some people have come to their first plant event and are surprised to see how enjoyable it is. Just meeting and talking to some of our vendors and hearing their passion and knowledge for what they grow/make is inspiring. For a short period you can forget about the negatives that are happening in our wider community and just enjoy the company of like minded people.

Each year we invite several media and garden personalities. People like Vasili and Jane Edmanson have been coming to most events since the start. Over the years we have also had Tino Carnevale, Sophie Thomson, Angus Stewart and many others. This year we have Costa, Jane and Vasili as our main guests plus many others who have written, presented and researched on specific topics that are important to having great gardens. Every person we have had has done one or two presentations or workshops but have also walked around the event meeting our attendees. What is interesting is they get as much enjoyment meeting and talking with the plant collectors, experienced gardeners and novices as the visitors do talking to them. It just shows how good our industry is and how we can all find enjoyment in something so common on our lives: plants.

As we deal with the plus and minuses of our busy time of year we must take time to reflect on what we do. The fact that every plant we produce is good for the environment. Every time someone puts a plant in a pot or the ground they are touching a living thing and connecting with the soil. We generate that!

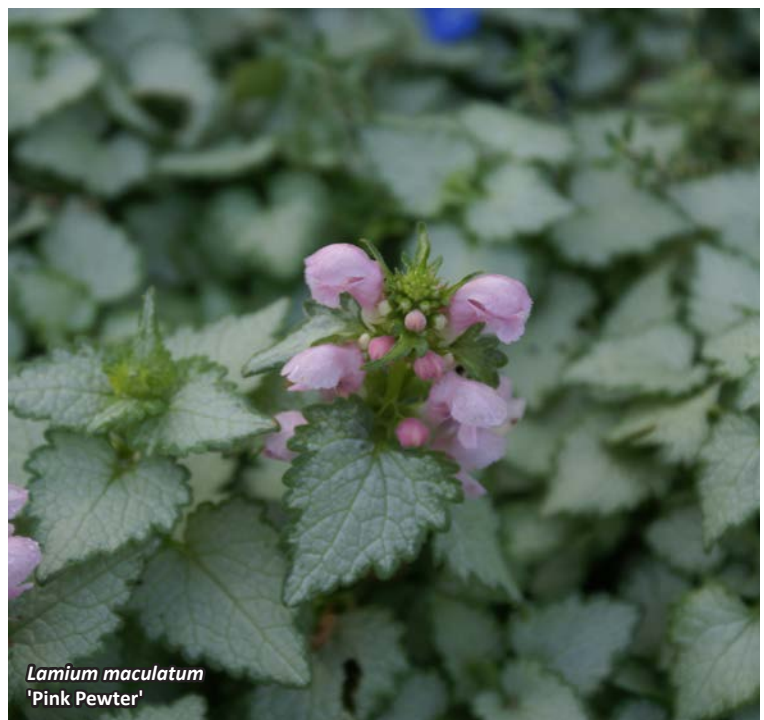

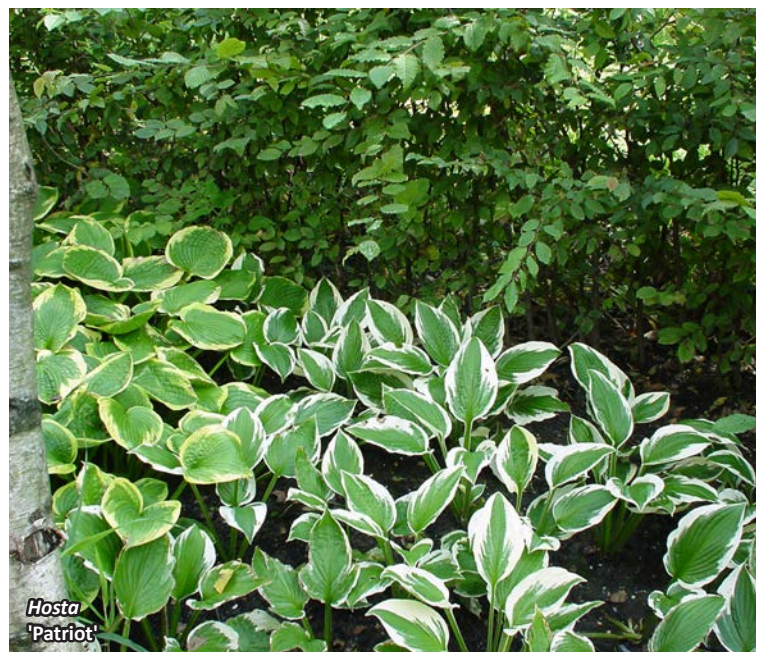
